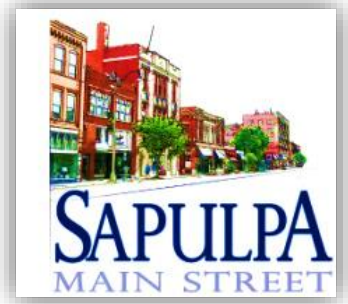


Sapulpa Main Street

Façade Grant Application



Projects Allowed

- Exterior Painting (Not Holiday Painting)
- Masonry Repair and Painting
- Signage (Permanent, Not temporary signage)
- Rehabilitation of Historic Signage and Awnings
- Removal of various façades that obscure the historical façade that lies underneath it.
- Other repairs or renovations that will help with restoring the historic significance and value of the structure.
- Must be within the Sapulpa Main Street District. (See Attached Map)

Additional Assistance & Incentives

- Free architectural assistance to help with downtown commercial properties.
- Greater potential in attracting new businesses.
- Creating a positive visual change for downtown.
- Enhanced community pride by creating catalysts for positive economic development of the Downtown Historical District.

Grant Requirements & Approval Process

- Grant submission must be for an ACTIVE business, and must still be in business at the time of grant presentation.
- If you are a business owner, you must have written consent from the building owner to complete said work. Please provide copy of consent with your application.
- Business must be a partner with Sapulpa Main Street.
- Project must be completed PRIOR to grant application being considered.
- Before and After photos MUST accompany your application as well as copies of paid invoices and receipts from your project. Any application that does not have photos or invoices & receipts will not be considered.
- Every year there will be a maximum of \$3,000 available for façade grants.
- The grant money could be distributed as either one grant up to \$3,000 or multiple grants that add up to a maximum of \$3,000.
- These are 50% matching grants. For example: A project that costs \$1,000 dollars, Main Street would only match 50% of the project, \$500. If the project costs more than \$6,000 dollars, then the maximum matching grant costs would only be \$3,000.
- Grant application approval is not guaranteed. Number of submissions, as well as other contributing factors determine grant approval.

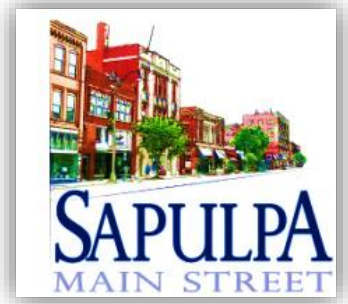
Not Eligible for Grant

- Sandblasting of brick or masonry surfaces
- New construction, as in a new building that did not exist in that location
- Removal of historic or architecturally significant features of a structure
- Labor performed by the applicant or friends of the applicant
- Any work that was performed that does not meet the standards listed above and/or was not on the original application

Historical Preservation Committee has to approve SIGNS/AWNINGS before grant approval.

This grant is not for residential structures.

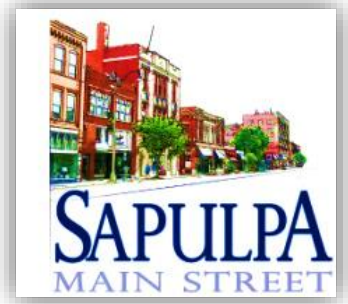
